DAVIS COUNTY ORDINANCE #2

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE ON SITE WASTE WATER DISPOSAL RULES OF THE IOWA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE (CHAPTER69), FOR DAVIS COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, THE STATE OF IOWA HAS ENACTED LEGISLATION SETTING THE STANDARDS FOR SITE WASTE WATER DISPOSAL IN THE STATE, AND

WHEREAS, THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES HAS ADOPTED RULES TO IMPLEMENT THE SAID STATUTORY PROVISIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DAVIS COUNTY, IOWA: THAT THE SAID CHAPTER 69 OF IOWA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IN ITS ENTIRETY SHALL HENCEFORTH BE THE ON SITE WASTE WATER DISPOSAL RULES OF DAVIS COUNTY.

2 (1) Applications of Rules:

(The following is deleted) Prior to selling or transferring of property that maintains an On-Site Wastewater Treatment and Disposal System. The owner must show proof that the present system is in accordance with this ordinance or so state within a contract that the present system will be altered, repaired or a new system installed within a specified time frame upon selling of said property.
