

YARD WASTE DISPOSAL
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL

CHAPTER I

SEPARATION FOR YARD WASTE FROM ALL OTHER GARBAGE AND REFUSE

SECTION 1. PURPOSE: HOUSE FILE 753 WAS SIGNED INTO LAW BY THE GOVERNOR OF IOWA ON MAY 31, 1989. SECTION 9, PARAGRAPH I STATES, "BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1991, LAND DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE IS PROHIBITED."

SECTION 2. DEFINITION: "YARD WASTE MEANS DEBRIS, SUCH AS GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, GARDEN WASTE, BRUSH AND TREES. YARD WASTE DOES NOT MEAN TREE STUMPS."

SECTION 3. REQUIREMENTS: IT SHALL BE REQUIRED THAT ALL YARD WASTE ORIGINATING IN DAVIS COUNTY AND ENTERING THE OTTUMWA-WAPELLO COUNTY LANDFILL, OR PLACED AT ANY COLLECTION POINT TO BE DELIVERED TO THE LANDFILL, SHALL BE SEPARATED FROM ALL OTHER WASTE. IF A COLLECTION SYSTEM FOR SOLID WASTE IN RURAL DAVIS COUNTY IS ADOPTED, THE COUNTY SUPERVISORS MAY, BY RESOLUTION, SET OUT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR YARD WASTE COLLECTION; YARD WASTE CONTAINERS, TIME LIMITS FOR SETTING CONTAINERS OUT, NUMBER OF CONTAINERS, COLLECTION FEES, LICENSING OF YARD WASTE HAULERS AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1991 AFTER ITS FINAL PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

SECTION 5. VALIDITY: SHOULD ANY SECTION OR PROVISION OF THIS ORDINANCE BE DECLARED, IN A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION, TO BE INVALID, THAT DECISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF THE ORDINANCE AS A WHOLE, OR ANY PART THEREOF, OTHER THAN THE PART SO DECLARED TO BE INVALID.

ALL ORDINANCES MUST BE PROPERLY CERTIFIED.
