The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, November 20, 2017, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present. During public comments, one citizen spoke to the Board.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Thursday, November 9 and Monday, November 13, 2017.

The Board met with Roger Wuthrich, who reported that the library is hoping to open the first of the year and offering use of the conference room to the Supervisors and other community organizations.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman. He has replaced shrubs, trimmed remaining shrubs, tested the boilers, and received a quote for a blade for the lawnmower.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who told the Board that removal of the Robin Boulevard bridge will start next week, final plans for C. William Brown bridge have been submitted to DOT, and Bull Jones bridge structure was removed last week.

After discussion, it was agreed that the employee Christmas party will be a pot luck lunch on December 20. Ron Bride offered to work with Randy Norman to transport and install decorations for the courtyard, with the help of any interested employees.

During committee reports, Matt Greiner reported on meetings of the Hospital Foundation and Fox River Watershed; Alan Yahnke reported on meetings of Decategorization Executive Committee, Emergency Services Agency, and LEPC; Ron Bride reported on meetings of Mutchler Commission, Wapello County landfill, and Chariton Valley Transportation Planning Commission.

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis, Chief Deputy Josh O'Dell, Deputy Josh Sinott and Civil Deputy Renetta Blew to discuss wording of a section of the proposed employee handbook. After discussion, it was agreed that Matt Greiner will speak with the resource specialist preparing the handbook to make the section concerning employment of relatives compliant with Iowa Code.
