The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, February 27, 2017, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Public comments were received from five individuals.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Tuesday, February 21, and Thursday, February 23, 2017.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on maintenance projects.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; the Assistant Engineer reported on bridge projects and presented right-of-way documents and federal aid agreements for signature.

The Board met with Diana Hughell of Pathfinders R C & D, who commented about the condition of roads making up the Scenic Byway and questioned whether there was funding for repairs. She also asked permission to put up a "Byway Closed" sign if the road is not improved. Ryan Schock stated that the highway will be paved this summer from the turnoff south of Lake Wapello to Unionville.

The Board met with Assistant County Attorney Ashley Leyda Walkup and, after discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to rescind motions passed last week transferring certain tax sale certificates to Lincoln Lynch and John Hilbert due to incorrect sales amounts. Thereafter, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to transfer six tax sale certificates to Lincoln Lynch for the total amount of \$4,931. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to transfer one tax sale certificate to John Hilbert for the total amount of \$1,861.25.

The Board met with Stephen Rodriguez of Iowa Statewide Interoperable Communications System, who is seeking permission to install a radio tower at the Davis Center property for use by public safety entities with no cost to the county. No action taken.

The Board considered a letter from Davis Center concerning construction of a smoking building; the matter was tabled until further research concerning insurance.

The Board reviewed an amendment by Iowa Economic Development Authority concerning CDBG program contract; Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign same.

The Board met with Title VI Coordinator Carol Herbert and discussed upcoming site review scheduled by Iowa DOT Compliance Officer Steve Kerber; no action taken.

The Board reviewed an email from Bill Menner offering mediation services; Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to have a telephone conference so long as there is no cost to the county.

Consideration of a public parking survey was tabled.

During committee reports, Ron Bride spoke about the mental health meeting and required core and core plus services, and also mentioned the bill to combine county governments.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the following claims to be paid:
