The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, February 5, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, January 29, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who told the Board he has priced a new pump for the courthouse heating system and will purchase the lowest priced one; discussion also held concerning the elevator in the courthouse.

The Board met with Bret Davis of the County Engineer's Office. Bids were opened for White's Dairy bridge, and Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to accept the lowest bid, being that of Iowa Bridge & Culvert at \$160,764. Contracts were also signed with Bloomfield Bridge & Culvert for the Hougland box culvert.

The Board opened the only bid for the 2001 Buick LeSabre and Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to accept the bid of Mike Johnson at \$701.00.

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis and Chief Deputy Josh O'Dell and opened bids for lawn care and snow removal at the Law Enforcement Center. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the bids of James Kuberski for both services.

After discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve software upgrade contract with Tyler Technologies. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve computer network wiring upgrade with Citizens Mutual Telephone.

During committee reports, Alan Yahnke reported on meetings of the Board of Health and SIEDA; Ron Bride reported on meeting of South Central Behavioral Health Region.

The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. to review office budgets with Auditor Linda Humphrey; Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to publish the proposed budget as approved.
