Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 5, 2018.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on various bridge projects.
