The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 27, 2017, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 20, 2017.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on painting projects and preparation of lawnmower for spring.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; Assistant Engineer Ryan Schock reported that the quarry is running out of 1 ½ inch rock and soon smaller rock will be hauled. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve utility permit for Southern Iowa Electric. After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to hire Ryan Schock as County Engineer, with a three-month probation period and a seven per cent raise from his current pay.

No action was taken concerning Statewide Interoperable Communications System lease.

After discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve beer license for Davis County Ag Society for specific events of rodeo, auto races, and concert during the Davis County Fair.

The Board met with Community Services Director Jane Harris, who presented Psychiatric State Papers for approval of payment by the mental health region to University of Iowa Clinics for a county resident. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve same.

The Board met with Assessor Lois Heckethorn concerning property tax credits and exemptions. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve letters of denial of four 2016 Family Farm tax credits. Matt Greiner also made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve credits as submitted for 2016 business property credits; 2017 forest reserve exemptions; 2017 impoundment structure exemptions; 2017 geothermal exemptions; and 2017 pollution control exemptions.

During committee reports, Ron Bride reported concerning meetings of Main Street and Southeast Iowa Detention; Matt Greiner reported concerning the Senior Center; and Alan Yahnke reported concerning 10-15 Transit.

At 12:45 P.M., Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and, by roll call vote, carried unanimously, to go into closed session to discuss matters where litigation is imminent pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(c). Those present, in addition to the Board, were County Attorney Rick Lynch and Auditor Linda Humphrey. After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and, by roll call vote, carried unanimously, to go back into open session. No further action in open session.

At 1:30 p.m. the Board attended HIPAA kickoff meeting with Roger Shindell of Carosh Compliance Solutions.
