The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 6, 2017, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

During public comments, Sheila Westegard, Dale Taylor, and Ken Turner spoke to the Board.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, February 27, 2017.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on courtroom repairs.

The Board met with Secondary Roads. Bids for Fig Avenue bridge repairs were opened; Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to accept the lowest bid of \$177,784 from Bloomfield Bridge & Culvert, pending certification of amounts. Assistant Engineer Ryan Schock reported that Douds Stone has increased rock prices; and two vendors have provided prices for dust control application.

The Board met with J. L. Stogdill concerning Camp Wapello Boy Scouts. He requested that the access road be rocked and a tube placed, and that the Board provide a letter of support. Camp Wapello Will be hosting a “camporee” on April 28 through 30.

After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to sign a letter of support for grant submission for the Historical Society.

After discussion, no action was taken concerning a master matrix petition.

Upon presentation of the Davis County Historical Preservation Commission’s annual report, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the report for signature by the Chairman.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the SIDCA applications for repair of three Soap Creek Watershed structures.

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis, who reported on food donations for the open house to be held March 11 at the new jail facility.

The Board met with John Hansen, who gave a progress report on the jail project and presented bills for payment. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried

unanimously, to approve payments as requested. Matt Greiner also made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve change order for \$319.00.

The Board reconvened at 1:00. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke, to go into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Sec. 21.5(1)(i) to discuss and evaluate a county employee.
