The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 23, 2018, with Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present. During public comments, Mayor Dan Wiegand told the Board that parking paint around the square was removed over the weekend and new striping may be started as early as Friday to return parking as it was in September 2017.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 16, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that the courthouse lobby floor wax and polish project was completed.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on bridge projects and noted that the White Dairy bridge repair will be completed this week. Performance bond for Norris Asphalt safety shoulder project was signed.

The Board met with Patsy Boas, who requested permission to use the courtyard for Farmers Market on Tuesdays, beginning May 5, from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. through August 28 and on Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m, through October 20. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve same.

The Board met with Veteran Affairs Director Terry Bradley, who requested approval for his assistant to attend training in Reno, NV, for certification, with payment to be made from the VA budget. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve same.

After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve hiring Felicia Davison as a part time employee for the Recorder's Office.

During committee reports, Ron Bride reported on meetings of Public Safety Commission; Main Street, and Wapello County Landfill; Alan Yahnke reported on meetings of Davis County Development Corporation and Public Safety Commission; HIPAA Privacy Officer Carol Herbert reported on ISAC seminar concerning HIPAA requirements in county government.

The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. for staff meeting; discussion of general courthouse concerns.
