The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 2, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

The Board met with Cheryll Jones, and after discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to declare April Child Abuse Prevention Month.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 26, 2018.

The meeting with custodian Randy Norman was cancelled. After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve application of fertilizer and herbicide for the courthouse lawn as proposed.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who gave the Board updates on bridge projects, and explained that no funding is available from the DOT at this time for destination lighting on Beowulf road but the DOT will notify him in May or June if funding is available. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to sign utility permit for Alliant Energy and Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to sign utility permit for Northeast Missouri Electric Cooperative.

At 10:00 a.m. budget amendment hearing was called to order. There being no public comments, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously to close the hearing. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the amendment as presented and as previously published in *The Bloomfield Democrat*. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve Resolution for Appropriations Amendment, as follows:

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve alcohol license application for “The Meadows”.

The Board met with Assessor Lois Heckethorn and approved applications for Family Farm Tax Credits, with 6 letters of denial.

Discussion of elevator modernization proposal was tabled until the Board can have conversation with the repairman.

During committee reports, Matt Greiner reported on meeting of Senior Citizens Commission; Ron Bride reported on meetings of Southern Iowa Mental Health and LEPC; Alan Yahnke reported on meetings of LEPC, Pioneer Cemetery, DCDC, 4 Counties 4 Kids, and the Historic Preservation Commission.
