The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, June 11, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, June 4, 2018.

The Board met with Ray Boas, Mark Wagner, and Tom Cope, who requested permission to use the courtyard at 7:00 a.m. on June 2 for non-denomination prayer meeting. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve use of the courtyard for the next four Tuesdays at any time during the day as they wish.
