The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, September 6, 2016, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride present.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 29, 2016.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; the Engineer reported on progress of the City of Floris bridge work. After discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to sign SIDCA watershed application.

Pursuant to Chapter 331.477, Code of the State of Iowa, Ron Bride made motion to approve Resolution to temporarily loan \$100,000 from the General Supplemental Fund to the Rural Basic Fund to cover operating expenditures. Said amount shall be returned to the General Supplemental Fund prior to June 30, 2017. Motion seconded by Dale Taylor and approved by the Board as follows:
