The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, January 20, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, January 13, 2020.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported boiler problems that are being worked on this morning.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that crews were out for snow removal until 5:00 pm Friday and from 7:00 am until noon on Saturday. He also updated on bridge projects and alternate possibilities for the Ash Grove bridge.

The Board met with Veterans Affairs Director Tisha Scott; after discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to increase the salary of the Director to \$21,403 annually, effective today.

The Board met with Assistant County Attorney Ashley Leyda Walkup and discussed details of proposed wind energy ordinance, including a review of ordinances in place in other counties.

The board reviewed proposed budgets with Auditor Linda Humphrey.
