The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, January 6, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Thursday, January 2, 2020.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on removal of Christmas decorations.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who updated on Janssen bridge progress and reported that he has been working on the FY21 budget and the County Five Year Plan for bridges and roads.

The Board met with Roger Wuthrich, who presented the current and projected budget for the Bloomfield Public Library.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Davis County Compensation Board meets annually to recommend a compensation schedule for elected officials for the fiscal year immediately following, in accordance with Iowa Code Chapters 331.905 and 331.907, and

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the quarterly reports of the Auditor, the Recorder, and the Sheriff.

Re-appointment of Real Estate Compensation Commission members was tabled until next week.

The Board met with Chief Deputy Josh Sinnott and discussed budget issues and possible changes in dispatcher and jailer staffing. No action taken.

The Board met with Assistant County Attorney Ashley Leyda Walkup and discussed items to be included in a possible wind energy ordinance.

Ron Bride reported on committee meetings attended.

Matt Greiner moved to adjourn; Alan Yahnke seconded; carried unanimously.
