The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 9, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Member Alan Yahnke present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

During public comments, a citizen inquired about a driveway needing done.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 2, 2020.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on Janssen bridge progress and explained a possible road surface project west of Drakesville; Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to sign utility permit for Southern Iowa Electric on Timber Ave.

At 10:00 a.m., hearing on maximum levy was called to order. There being no public comments, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to close the hearing. Alan Yahnke then made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and, by roll call vote, carried unanimously, to adopt the following maximum levy resolution and set March 23, 2020 for budget hearing.

RESOLUTION

Approval of FY2021 Maximum Property Tax Dollars

WHEREAS, the Davis County Board of Supervisors have considered the proposed Fiscal Year 2021 county maximum property tax dollars for both General County Services and Rural County Services, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was published as required on county web site and/or social media accounts if applicable, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was held on March 9, 2020,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Davis County that the maximum property tax dollars for General County Services and Rural County Services for FY2021 shall not exceed the following:

General County Services \$2,792,852

Rural County Services \$1,166,925

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in either General County Services or Rural County Services for FY2021 does not represent an increase of 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY2020.

Discussion of wind energy ordinance was tabled.

Discussion was held with Sheriff Dave Davis and Chief Deputy Josh Sinnott concerning method of funding to replace damaged Sheriff's Department vehicle; Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride, and carried unanimously, to amend current 2020 fiscal year budget for purchase of vehicle scheduled to be purchased in July 2020.

Discussion was held concerning continuity of government in event of disaster or disruption of government services affecting courthouse officials; no action taken.
