The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 23, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign both the Minutes of Monday, March 16, 2020, and Wednesday, March 18, 2020.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that 4,516 tons of rock was hauled last week, that the Janssen bridge on Jewel Avenue is nearly complete, and as a precautionary safety measure regarding the COVID -19 (or Corona Virus), the Engineer's office would be closed to the public, until further notice.

Matt Greiner also made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the 2021 Five Year Plan, as presented by the Engineer.

Budget hearing was convened at 10:00 a.m. There being no public discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to close the hearing. Matt Greiner then made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke, and carried unanimously, to Approve the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION Approval of FY 2020/21 Budget and Certification of Taxes

WHEREAS, the Davis County Board of Supervisors has considered the proposed FY 2020/2021 county budget and certification of taxes, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed county budget was held on February 24, 2020,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Davis County, Iowa, that the county budget and certification of taxes for FY2020/2021, as set forth in the budget summary, is hereby adopted and that the Davis County Auditor is directed to file said budget and to establish accounting records in accordance with the attached schedules.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the chairperson and the County Auditor be and are hereby authorized to sign the approved FY 2020/2021 county budget.

Discussion was held with J. L. Stogdill (Pulaski Town Clerk) regarding a parcel of county owned property, located in Pulaski, in which the town has an interest in ownership. The board has directed the Assistant County Attorney to move forward with the process to accomplish this.

After much discussion regarding the COVID-19 (or Corona Virus), Matt Greiner made the motion to make it a county-wide policy for any employees returning from time off, which included air travel, to mandatorily self-quarantine for a period up to 14 (fourteen) days upon their return to the county. This 14 day leave will be subject to the county sick leave plan and/or FMLA guidelines.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner, and carried unanimously to approve a credit card purchase for postage, for the Treasurer's office, over the \$500 limit not requiring approval.

There was also discussion regarding the tree removal at the County Home farm property. No action taken.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
