The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, September 14, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Alan Yahnke and Matt Greiner present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

During public comments, Jake Bohi questioned the Board about their position on the recent Ordinance by the City of Bloomfield regarding ATV permits.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, September 8, 2020. Ron Bride abstained, due to his absence from that meeting.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that he has stopped watering the trees in the courtyard, due to the welcome 6 inches of rain last week.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on general road maintenance, consisting of mowing, blading and rock hauling. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve a utility permit for Citizens Mutual Telephone Company for a location on 212th St.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to rescind a resolution from last week, requesting reimbursement for eligible costs related to the COVID-19 public health emergency from the Iowa COVID-19 Government Relief Fund, due to confusion with this grant and a different COVID-19 grant from HAVA (Help America Vote Act) that is allocated only for election funding.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
