The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, October 5, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Alan Yahnke and Matt Greiner present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

There were no comments made by the public.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, September 28, 2020.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, where he reported regular maintenance issues. After discussion, it was determined that Loktronics Security Corp. would be hired to replace a pair of door locks at the courthouse and a roof repair estimate would be sought for the building on 203 S. Madison Street.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on road maintenance projects throughout the county, including a resurfacing project, that will begin today, West of Drakesville.

After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the Quarterly Revenue report from the Sheriff.
