The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, December 14, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Alan Yahnke and Matt Greiner present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, December 7, 2020.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that the roof repairs for the property on 203 S. Madison St. were completed and also discussed solutions for moving filing cabinet storage during the courthouse basement project.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, and discussed all current county road and bridge projects, and an ordinance to require Right-Of-Way work permits.

The Board met with Jackie White regarding the West Grove Crossroads Church, and a request to have the taxes forgiven for the years of 2018 -2021. The matter was tabled until more research can be done.

The Board met with Assessor Lois Heckethorn to review all applications for the “Family Farm” tax credit. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to deny one claim and approve all others.

Matt Greiner made motion to approve a letter of support for the Davis County Agricultural Society (Davis County Fair) to acquire a grant for additional security equipment.

Chief Deputy Josh Sinnott discussed the loss of a Sheriff deputy’s vehicle, the insurance claim, and pending cost estimate for replacement.

All Board members relayed that they had attended no additional meetings last week.
