The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, February 8, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

There were no public comments.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, February 1, 2021.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who discussed the recurrent snow events and frequent snow removal efforts for the Courthouse premises.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who also discussed the ongoing snow events and their efforts with clearing roads and keeping their equipment running, in the unusual and severe cold. The agenda item to approve a utility permit was postponed.

The Board met with Tom Prosapio to discuss the accessibility project for the basement of the Courthouse. He presented a proposal from Environmental Edge, for asbestos abatement in the amount of \$3,512.50. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the proposal as presented.

The Board discussed the appointment of a Supervisor's representative to become an authorized signer for the Davis County Historic Preservation Fund bank account. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the removal of Dale Taylor and appointment of Alan Yahnke as signatory of the account.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve a resolution providing financial support of the Area 15 Regional Planning Commission, and Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve a resolution of financial commitment for the AHEAD Regional Housing and Trust Fund.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
