The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Tom Prosapio shared information regarding the progress of the basement construction project as a public comment discussion.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 1, 2021.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that the annual inspection of all fire extinguishers had been completed satisfactorily by Summit Companies, and the courtyard Christmas decorations have been removed.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who informed the Board that bridge work had begun again on both Jade and Mahogany Avenue bridges. There was also discussion regarding the crack sealing projects and seal coating plans for Timber Avenue, South of Pulaski, in the near future.
