The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 18, 2016, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 11, 2016.

The Board met with Ernie Bohi, who discussed road blading issues.

The Board met with Secondary Roads. Bids were opened for rock program and, as the only bid was from Douds Stone for 13 locations for a total of \$500,860, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve same upon review and calculation check. Work continues on the airport road bridge and Quill Avenue bridge; Polkey bridge project is complete; and Scarlet Avenue low water crossing closed until repairs can be made. The Bunch paving project will be delayed because the Hull/Quigley General Store is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places and vibration monitoring must be done before the project can be started. Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve extending the bargaining agreement from two years to three years.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve a Class "B" beer license for Davis County Ag Society, d/b/a Bloomfield Speedway.

The Board met with John Schroeder and Dave Davis, who requested permission for the Rotary Club to set up a tent in the courtyard on Thursday, June 23 through July 5 for Hairy Nation/July 4 celebration. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve same.

The Board met with Lynn Davidson, who requested permission to use the southwest corner of the courtyard on May 17, 2016, for the Bloomfield Main Street annual banquet. Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve same.
