The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, February 22, 2016, roll call indicated that Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride were present.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Tuesday, February 16, 2016.

The Board met with Secondary Roads. The resolution concerning vacating a portion of Dill Avenue was tabled until next week. After discussion Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve submitting of SIDCA application for three Big Wyacondah Watershed projects. A 28E agreement is being discussed with the City of Drakesville concerning the oval and area sidewalks. After discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve resolution to add to 173<sup>rd</sup> Street and a small portion of Walnut Street as a Farm-to-Market road. Payment for repair of abutment damage to the Fig Avenue bridge has been rejected by FEMA but will be appealed.

After discussion, Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve ADLM Resolution for repayment of loan funds, as previously approved.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to pay for tourism liability insurance beginning fiscal year 2017.

The amended Pioneer Cemetery Commission Ordinance was read aloud; Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to waive the third reading of said ordinance; public hearing was called to order at 10:00 a.m. and there being no public comments, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to close the hearing. Ron Bride then made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the Ordinance as read.

The Board met with John Schroeder, who had questions about farm organizations.

Ron Bride reported on the courthouse handicap ramp specifications as proposed in the Bloomfield Streetscape plans.

Review of office budgets was held after continuing labor negotiations.
