The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, May 3, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

There were no public comments.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 26, 2021.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who requested permission to purchase additional mulch for the courtyard flower beds.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on current work being done by the county crews, and the continuing progress of the bridge crews. He also reported of the intent to begin a crack seal job on Lilac Avenue later this week, and more work to start this fall, beginning on the Floris Road.

A public hearing was convened at 10:00 a.m. for the courthouse "Accessibility Access Addition" project. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously to close the hearing. There being no public discussion or comments, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the project to release for bids.

The Board met with Heidi Kuhl, from Northland Securities, regarding the details and calendar of the upcoming bond financing for the multiple road repaving project.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and authorize the County Auditor, Linda Humphrey, to sign a letter of engagement with Dorsey & Whitney, LLP, as Davis County's bond counsel, for a proposed General Obligation county road improvement bonds.

The Board considered a courtyard location for the placement of a historic marker, citing the Davis County courthouse and the Bloomfield Square, as highlights on the Historic Hills Scenic Byway. After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously to approve a location in the Southeast quadrant of the courtyard for placement.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
