The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, June 1, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

There were no comments from the public.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, May 17, 2021 and Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, May 24, 2021.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that the State boiler inspection has been completed.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that the roads crews are preparing roads for the first dust control application this week, and have been doing road patching in the towns of Troy and Floris, and other locations. He also stated that the Jade Avenue Bridge project is nearing completion, and that Nuthatch Avenue, South of Highway 2, will be closed for a bridge repair work from June 3<sup>rd</sup> through June 10<sup>th</sup>. It is expected to be re-opened on the 11<sup>th</sup>.

The Board met with Tori Ward, from Bloomfield Main Street, who asked for permission to use the courtyard for the Farmer's Market during the 2021 summer season. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the request.

The Board met with Chief Deputy Josh Sinnott, and discussion was held regarding the parking and heavy traffic situation that has developed due to the new baseball complex situated west of Bloomfield. It was noted that the school is searching for possible remedies as well. No action was taken.

A discussion scheduled regarding signage for the Mormon Trail Association was cancelled.

Discussion was held regarding the HIPAA service agreement renewal of Davis County with ISAC (Iowa State Association of Counties). Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the renewal agreement.
