The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 16, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner present and Member Ron Bride joining the meeting via telephone. Member Alan Yahnke was absent.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 9, 2021.

The Board met with Karen Spurgeon, who requested the use of the courtyard for Wednesday, August 25, 2021, for the annual "Meet The Mustangs" event. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the use for this event.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that he had removed a tree limb that had fallen in the courtyard and was painting some trim in the basement.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that the bump had been repaired on the bridge approach on Nuthatch Avenue, and that there would be patching done south of Pulaski this year, and then millwork, followed by two sealing coats for that pavement by November 2022.

Garmon Morse spoke to the Engineer and the Board regarding his concerns of the road conditions near his home on 170<sup>th</sup> St, near Belknap.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.

The Board met with Tom Prosapio, construction manager for the Accessible Entry Addition of the courthouse. He gave a start date of September 9, 2021, and provided the Board with a tentative schedule for the entire project, citing completion by the end of October.
