The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 30, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 23, 2021.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who discussed the “Meet the Mustangs” event, held in the courtyard on Wednesday evening of last week.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that the county crews were blading, hauling rock, mowing, and doing ditch work with the track hoe and the rubber-tired hoe. He also stated that the southern Cedar Avenue bridge was having beams set this week. He expects that they will also begin putting the decking on.

The Board met with Tom Prosapio, general construction manager for the Courthouse Accessibility project, and discussed that tentative work schedule and plans to begin on September 7, 2021.

The Board met with Davis County Assessor, Lois Heckethorn, for an update on the City of Bloomfield’s Urban Renewal Plan Consultation meeting that she recently attended.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve a provision change to the voluntary AIG-VALIC employee retirement services plan, for any participant wishing to withdraw funds from it. The current plan stated that the participant must reach the age of 70 ½ prior to withdrawal of funds, but a 2019 law change has made it possible to lower that to age limit to 50 ½, with Board approval.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
