The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, January 31, 2022, with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Members Ron Bride and Matt Greiner present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, January 24, 2022.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, for a discussion on general courthouse maintenance.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the County crews doing blading, hauling rock and other projects with the Track Hoe, and Rubber Tired Hoe.

The Board met with Tom Prosapio for an update on the Courthouse Accessibility project. He reported that the elevator lift had passed the inspection by the State, but would not be available for use without assistance, until signage regarding operation instructions could be placed.

The Board met with Mike Howk, from Big Iron Auction Service, for a presentation on the options available to them, for auction services.

The Board met with Tammy Roberts, Bloomfield Community Development Director, regarding a CDBG grant application. Her request was for the Board to agree that Davis County would be the applicant for a non-matching grant, to install fiberoptic broadband coverage in the southeast corner of the County.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to be the grant applicant.

A discussion was held regarding a recommendation from IMWCA (Iowa Municipalities Workers' Compensation Association) that the County establish a Safety Committee. It was determined that since this might assist in receiving Workers Compensation insurance at a discounted rate, the Supervisors agreed to form this committee.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to accept, and publish the Annual Employee Wage Report for 2021, as follows:
