The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, July, 2022, with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Members Ron Bride and Matt Greiner present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Tuesday, July 5, 2022.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that the boilers and system passed the recent inspection and we should be receiving the certifications from the State soon.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the work projects of the County crews. They are blading, hauling rock and ditching.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign a document engaging Northland Securities as a placement agent for possible financing of a road paving project.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve quarterly cash reports, as presented, from the Auditor, Recorder and Sheriff.

After discussion regarding a Department of Transportation project to repave Highway 63 through Bloomfield, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to send a letter to the City of Bloomfield stating the County's wish to keep the portion of highway 63 traveling on the East side of the city square to 4 (four) lanes and not change it to 3 (three) lanes.

At 2:30 P.M. the Board re-convened for a staff meeting.
