The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, October 31, 2022, with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Members Ron Bride and Matt Greiner present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, October 24, 2022.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, and they discussed snow removal plans for the approaching winter season. He also reported that 1 of the 6 courthouse boilers is currently not working and is waiting on a replacement part to make the necessary repair.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on work being done by the County crews. Besides mowing and blading, they were clearing ditches on 212th St. and also on Dewberry Ave.
