The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 21, 2023 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Dave Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

Dave Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Karen Spurgeon, publisher of *The Bloomfield Democrat*, stopped in to compliment the progress of the gazebo. She also asked Chairman Ron Bride to speak briefly about the new gazebo at the Meet the Mustangs event to be held September 30, 2023.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Dave Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 14, 2023.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on general courthouse maintenance.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who commented on the various activities of the county crews, blading, mowing, hauling rock and ditching. He reported Huggins Concrete will begin the patch work on J40 midweek.

Several members of the Amish community attended the board meeting to discuss the severe damage caused by horseshoes to paved roads. They are open to ideas for lessening the damage.

County Treasurer, Mike Johnson, requested approval for a credit card purchase over the previously set limit of \$1,500.00, due to postage needed for pending mailings. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Dave Henderson and carried unanimously to approve the purchase.
