The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, January 29, 2024 with Chairman David Henderson and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, January 22, 2024.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the snow removal, blading, rock and sand hauling, and brush cutting activities of the County crews. He discussed the tree and brush removal taking place on some major paved roads within the County. He told the supervisors that this is being paid for by a grant from the Department of Transportation.

Discussion was held with several members of the Amish Safety Committee, regarding the impact of “aggressive” horseshoes on asphalt roads. They presented results from their own experimentation with different types of horseshoes. They stated that they hope continuing an open communication with the supervisors and providing education in their own community that a solution can be found. No action was taken.
