The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 22, 2024 with Chairman David Henderson and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 15, 2024.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling, and brush cutting activities of the County crews.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the utility permit for Rathbun Regional Water Association for a location on Fawn Avenue.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve up to \$500.00 for the Master Gardener Courtyard Flower Bed Revitalization Plan and Funding.
