

2024 GENERAL ELECTION CALENDAR

- **Monday, August 5, 2024: County Candidate Filing Begins**
 - First day for non-party political organization (NPPO) candidates and candidates nominated by petition to file nomination papers for county and township offices with the auditor.
- **Friday, August 23, 2024: Primary Nominee Withdrawal Deadline – County**
 - Last day for candidates for county office who were nominated in the Primary Election to withdraw. Notice of withdrawal must be submitted in writing to the auditor.
 - **Last Day for Vacancies - County:**
If a midterm vacancy in a county office occurs on or before today and no special election is called to fill the vacancy, the office must be on the ballot to fill the vacancy at the General Election. Political party nominations must be made by convention.
- **Tuesday, August 27, 2024:**
 - **First day to submit absentee ballot requests**
 - **Proxy Requests Begin:**
First day for family members of UOCAVA voters to submit proxy absentee ballot request forms.
- **Wednesday, August 28, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Filing Deadline – County:** Last day to file nomination papers for county offices with the auditor. This includes NPPO candidates, candidates nominated by petition, candidates for non-partisan offices and Democratic, Libertarian and Republican parties' nominations to fill ballot vacancies. Deadline is 5 p.m.
- **Tuesday, September 3, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Withdrawal Deadline – County:** Last day for NPPO candidates and candidates nominated by petition who filed nomination papers with the auditor to withdraw. Notice of withdrawal must be submitted in writing to the Auditor
 - **Objection Deadline: County:** Last Day to File a written objection to nomination papers files with the Auditor. Deadline is 5 p.m.
- **Thursday, September 19, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Satellite Voting Petition Deadline:** A petition requesting a satellite absentee voting station must be filed no later than 5 p.m.
- **Wednesday, October 16, 2024: Absentee Voting Begins.**
 - First day absentee ballots may be mailed or voted in the Auditor's Office during regular business hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- **Monday, October 21, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Worry-Free Postmark Date.** Mailed voter registration forms which are postmarked on or before today are considered on time to be pre-registered for the General Election even if they are received after the pre-registration deadline.

- **Monday, October 21, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Voter Pre-Registration Deadline.** The deadline to pre-register to vote in the General Election is 5 p.m. This applies to registration in person (including at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail. Voters may register online until 11:59 p.m.
 - **Absentee Ballot by Mail Request Deadline.** Deadline to request an absentee ballot be mailed is 5:00 p.m.

- **Friday, November 1, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Deadline to Submit Written Challenges to Absentee Voters.** A person qualified to vote in the election may submit a written challenge to the qualifications of an absentee voter until 5 p.m. in the Auditor's Office.

- **Saturday, November 2, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office Open 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - The Auditor's Office must be open for at least 8 hours for absentee voting and other election business.

- **Monday, November 4, 2024: Absentee Ballot In-Person Deadline.**
 - Last day to request and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Auditor's Office.

- **Tuesday, November 5, 2024: GENERAL ELECTION DAY. Polls open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**
 - **Absentee Ballot Deadline.** All absentee ballots, except UOCAVA and Safe at Home, must be received by 8:00 p.m. to be considered on time to be counted.
 - **Last Day for Voters to Fix Incomplete Affidavits.** Voters have until the close of polls at 8 p.m. to fix incomplete affidavit envelopes

- **Tuesday, November 12, 2024: County Canvass of Votes by the Board of Supervisors.**

- **Friday, November 15, 2024: Davis County Auditor's Office is open 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
 - **Recount Request Deadline.** Written requests for a recount must be filed with the auditor by 5 p.m. on the third day after the county canvass of votes.
