The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 7, 2025 with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Members Ron Bride and David Henderson present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 31, 2025.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on details of the County crews' activity, including sealing cracks on J40, blading, hauling rock, building up berms at decaying wing walls on 280<sup>th</sup> Street bridge and clearing brush out of a triple pipe on Scarlet Avenue. Engineer Schock also reported that he will be advertising two temporary part-time, summer mowing positions this week and next. He reported that the DOT (Department of Transportation) completed a speed study on Bunch Road and are recommending a rating of 55 miles per hour through an existing 45 miles per hour zone.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve a utility permit for CMTEL for a location on 195<sup>TH</sup> St.

After consideration, David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously to approve the auction contract with Merit Auction for the sale of the property locally known as "The County Home" and personal property.

The Board then discussed the continuation of repair and cleanup work because of water damage that occurred when a frozen water line broke. No action was taken.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously to approve the Quarterly Cash Reports for the Auditor, Recorder and Sheriff.

At 10:00 a.m., Chairman Alan Yahnke called to open a public hearing for the fiscal year 2026 County Budget. Members of the public, Earl Trachsel and Gary Horn, were present to ask questions and give comments. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously to close the hearing.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the Compensation Resolution #472025-A, which reads as follows:

WHEREAS, the Davis County Compensation Board meets annually to recommend a compensation schedule for elected officials for the fiscal year immediately following, in accordance with Iowa Code Chapters 331.905 and 331.907, and

WHEREAS, the Davis County Compensation Board met on December 16, 2024, and made the following salary recommendations for the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025:
