David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 11, 2025. David Henderson abstained from approval of said minutes as he was absent from the August 11<sup>th</sup> meeting.
