Thurs, Sept 18, 2025	City Election Filing Deadline Last Day to file nomination papers with the City Clerk . Deadline is 5 p.m. School Election Candidate Filing Deadline Last day to file nomination papers with the School Secretary or community college board secretary. Deadline is 5 p.m. Auditor's Office, City Clerk's Office and School Secretary's Office must be open until 5 p.m.
Tues, Sept 23, 2025	City Election Candidate Withdrawal Deadline Last day for candidates to withdrawal by filing a written request with the City Clerk . Deadline is 5 p.m. School Election Final Withdrawal Deadline Last day for candidates to withdrawal by filing a written request with the School Secretary . Deadline is 5 p.m. City Election Candidate Objection Deadline Last day to file written objections to nomination papers or eligibility of a candidate with the City Clerk . Deadline is 5 p.m. School & Community College Election Objection Deadline Last day to file written objections to nomination papers or eligibility of a candidate with the School Secretary or Community College Board Secretary. Auditor's Office, City Clerk's Office and School Secretary's Office must be open until 5 p.m.
Mon, Oct 6, 2025	Satelite Voting Petition Deadline for Regular City/School Election Auditor's Office Open Until 5 p.m.
Wed, Oct 15, 2025	First Day to vote absentee in-person at the Auditor's Office for City/School Election First day absentee ballots can be mailed for the City/School Election .

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Mon, Oct 20, 2025	Voter Pre-Registration Deadline The deadline to pre-register to vote for the City/School Election is 5 p.m. This applies to registration in person (including registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail. After today, a person may register to vote at the Auditor's Office and vote an absentee ballot. The process is the same as for registering to vote on election day. Deadline to request an absentee ballot be mailed. Worry-Free Postmark Date Mailed voter registration forms which are postmarked on or before today are considered on time to be pre-registered for the City/School Election even if they are received after the voter pre-registration deadline. Voters admitted to hospitals or nursing homes after 5 p.m. today may call to request delivery of an absentee ballot for the City/School Election. Deadline for a telephone request is 4 p.m. on election day. Auditor's Office must be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Fri, Oct 31, 2025	Last day to submit written challenges to absentee voters A person qualified to vote in the election may submit a written challenge to the qualifications of an absentee voter until 5 p.m. to the Auditor. Auditor's Office must be open until 5 p.m.
Mon, Nov 3, 2025	In-person absentee ballot deadline for City/School Election Last day to vote an absentee ballot in person at the Auditor's Office.
Tues, Nov 4, 2025	City/School Election Day Polls are open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. All absentee ballots (except UOCAVA and Safe at Home) must be received in the Auditor's Office by 8 p.m. to be considered on time to be counted. Last day for voters to fix incomplete Affidavits for the City/School Election. Voters have until 8 p.m. to fix incomplete Affidavit envelopes at the Auditor's Office.
Wed, Nov 12, 2025	1st-Tier County Canvas of Votes for the City/School Election
Thurs, Nov 13, 2025	Recount Request Deadline for Regular City/School Election Requests must be written and filed with the Auditor by 5 p.m. on the day after the county canvass. Auditor's Office must be open until 5 p.m.
Friday, Nov 14, 2025	Election Contest Notice for City Election Statement of intent to contest the election must be filed in the City Clerk's office no later than 10 days after the election.
Tues, Nov 18, 2025	2nd-Tier County Canvass for School Election

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Mon, Nov 24, 2025	Write-In Winner Resignation Deadline for Cities If a person is elected by write-in votes, they can submit their resignation in writing to the City Clerk by 5 p.m. by the tenth day after the canvass. City Clerk's Office must be open until 5 p.m. if necessary.
Mon, Dec 1, 2025	Election Contest Notice Deadline for School District Candidates if 1st-Tier Canvass was Final Canvass Statement of intent to contest election must be filed in the control auditor's office within 20 days after the apparent winner was declared elected.
Mon, Dec 8, 2025	Election Contest Notice Deadline for School District Candidates with 2nd Tier Statement of intent to contest election must be filed in the Auditor's Office within 20 days after the the the apparent winner was declared elected.
