The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, February 2, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Member David Henderson present. Member Alan Yahnke was absent.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, January 26, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling and brush cutting completed by the County crews.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to table the meeting with Dan Stockham regarding Parcel number 08058990.

The Board met with Information Technology (IT) Director, Megan Clyman, who explained that because of an employee error, the original Managed Services Renewal Agreement with “Secure Serve”, signed by 2025 Board Chairman Alan Yahnke on October 6, 2025, did not get correctly implemented into the said Secure Serve system. To correct this issue, David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to authorize Chairman Ron Bride to re-sign the Managed Services Renewal Agreement with Secure Serve to take effect March 1, 2026.

Dave Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the Special Class C Retail Alcohol License for the Davis County Agricultural Society (Davis County Fair) covering 2026 year of events.

The Board then discussed the need to appoint a willing lay person to fill a vacancy on the Judicial Magistrate Appointing Commission, said vacancy created upon the death of Elaine Perry. No action was taken.

The Board then discussed continued work as per recommendations by Alliance Environmental Services, who performed an Air Quality Test on the Courthouse December 29, 2025. Today, work to remove carpet in the Clerk’s office and replace with luxury vinyl tile and replace all ceiling tiles will begin.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
