The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 16, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 9, 2026. Alan Yahnke abstained as he was absent from the March 9, 2026 meeting.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling and brush cutting work of the County crews.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously to sign the utility permit for Rathbun Rural Water Association, Inc. on Yukon Avenue.

Tim Poyzer with Globe Life, a Family Heritage Division met with the Board to present an optional, non-payroll deduction, supplemental-coverage plan. Mr. Poyzer will be in contact with all department heads in the near future to schedule meetings with department heads and staff to present the same information.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously to approve the temporary road closure of Main Street in Floris for the Floris Flag Day event to be held on June 6, 2026. The County will provide signage for the closure.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously to opt out of the Community Services Network (CSN), a program offered through Iowa Counties Technology Services (ICTS) to manage mental and disability services. It should be noted that this decision was reached due to no departments within the county currently utilize said program that prior to July 1, 2026 was free of charge. Beginning July 1, 2026, counties will be charged a yearly fee of \$2,500 to participate in the CSN program.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve permitting VanMersbergen Insurance to provide the County's Certificate of Insurance from Iowa Communities Insurance Pool policy to the Lutheran Church, as the Veterans Affairs office is planning to hold their monthly Veterans' breakfast at the Lutheran Church.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
