The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 9, 2026, with Chairman Ron Bride and Member David Henderson. Member Alan Yahnke was absent.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 2, 2026.

After consideration, David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve removal of references to the provisions of the Rule to Support Reproductive Health Care Privacy that were vacated by a court in June of 2025 from the County Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act Policy and Procedure Manual (HIPAA), as presented by HIPAA Privacy Officer, Brenda Johnson.

After a lengthy discussion with Treasurer Mike Johnson and upon the guidance of Assistant County Attorney, Ashley Leyda-Walkup, David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to deny a written request from a citizen to abate, exempt or suspend taxes due on five non-homestead parcels of real estate.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling, mowing and brush cutting work being completed by County crews. He further reported on progress of the work to replace the "Richard Harris Bridge" and that we are waiting for beams for said project to arrive on Friday. He also reported that Stateline Bridge Company, L.L.C. is going out of business because of lack of work in Iowa and Missouri.

After a brief discussion, David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously to approve MJ's CountryScapes bid proposal in the amount of \$1,105 for 2026 lawn spraying.

During the Committee and Department Reports section of the meeting, Sheriff Zach Dunlavy reported on his department's intent to hold testing on March 21 in hopes to add at least two Reserve Deputies to his department. Sheriff Dunlavy stated this will be of great assistance when additional officers are needed during major County events such as the Fair and also for prisoner transport duties.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
