The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 13, 2026, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 6, 2026.

During the Public Comments section of the meeting, David Boas, County Farm tenant, was present to discuss the need for fence and crossing repair work in the near future. The Board directed the Board Secretary to add this subject to next week's agenda for discussion and possible action.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling and brush cutting work done by County crews. He further discussed a proposed Memorandum of Understanding drafted by the County's Union Negotiations Attorney with some minor adjustments to be made before presenting the same to Public, Professional, and Maintenance Employees Local Union No. 2003, International Union of Painters and Allied Trades Representative to then be voted upon by Secondary Roads employees. Engineer Schock then reported that the installation of replacement fuel pumps this Thursday will pause fuel tank operations for the day.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve the Fiscal Year 2027 County Five Year Plan as presented by the Engineer.

The Board met with Davis County Courthouse Preservation Fund members, Megan Clyman and Roger Wuthrich who reported their organization had approved hiring Klinger and Associates of Pella, Iowa to perform an assessment on the exterior of the Courthouse building structure, the goal and purpose of said assessment being to determine a scope of work and cost to complete needed repairs to the exterior of building. David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, in favor of moving forward with Davis County Courthouse Preservation Fund organization's recommendations.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve purchasing a pallet of mulch from Bloomfield True Value to be applied around the Courtyard by high school students in conjunction with "Mustang Pride Day" scheduled for May 15 with a rain date of May 22.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
