The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 20, 2026, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 13, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling and brush cutting activities of the County crews. He further reported that the deck on the "Richard Harris bridge" is scheduled to be poured tomorrow. He updated the Board that the fuel pumps remain out of service at the County shed pending troubleshooting by the vendor as to why the card reader and the pump are not communicating with one another.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve a resolution providing financial support to AHEAD Regional Housing Trust Fund for Fiscal Year 2026-2027, in the amount of \$1,822.00.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve a resolution providing financial support to Area 15 Regional Planning Commission for Fiscal Year 2026-2027, in the amount of \$3,236.20.
