The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 6, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 30, 2026.

The Board met with Cheryll Jones, Director of Policy & Advocacy Health Services Coordinator with Ottumwa Regional Center CHSC, who presented a proclamation naming the month of April as Child Abuse Prevention Month. David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the proclamation.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve the request by Veteran's Affairs Commissioners Junior Reese and Sammy Ford to place Veteran's banners upon light poles within the perimeter of the Courtyard, pending confirmation the poles are structurally sound to support the additional weight of said banners.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling, and brush cutting activities of the County crews.

Bids were opened for the 2026 Rock program. There were 13 different roads identified in the project, and 2 different bidders, Douds Stone and Cantera Aggregates.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously to approve the 13 projects, awarding 11 to Douds Stone and 2 to Cantera Aggregates, upon the Engineer's approval.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve a utility permit for Citizens Mutual Telephone Company on Beechwood Boulevard. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve a utility permit for Citizens Mutual Telephone Company to bore under 130th Street.

At 10:00 a.m., Chairman Ron Bride called to open a public hearing for the fiscal year 2027 County Budget. There being no comments or questions from the public, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously to close the hearing.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve the Compensation Resolution #462026-A, which reads as follows:

WHEREAS, the Davis County Compensation Board meets annually to recommend a compensation schedule for elected officials for the fiscal year immediately following, in accordance with Iowa Code Chapters 331.905 and 331.907, and

WHEREAS, the Davis County Compensation Board met on December 22, 2025, and made the following salary recommendations for the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board Chairman and the County Auditor be and are hereby authorized to sign the approved FY 2026/2027 county budget.
