The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 30, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 23, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, mulch application, rock hauling and brush cutting work completed by County crews. He further reported that work on the "Rex Stewart" pipe was finished Friday and the road opened that evening. Engineer Schock further reported that he received three quotes to replace the fuel pumps at the County Shed: 1) Midwest, \$39,471.21; 2) Evora, \$31,567.03, including tank sweeping; and, 3) Seneca, \$43,338.24. Discussion regarding the possibility of the Secondary Road's Department working four, ten-hour days from the Memorial Day through Labor Day time period and the details thereof will be forthcoming.
