The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, May 4, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 27, 2026.

After a discussion with representative, John Schroeder, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously to approve Bloomfield Rotary Foundation's use of the northwest section of the courtyard to place their tent and serve breakfast at the annual Hairy Nation Days and Fourth of July Pancake events.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve Conservation Director, Logan Faler's request to hire one temporary, part-time employee in his department who will help with mowing and weed eating duties for the summer.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, rock hauling, brush cutting and cross-road pipe repair work activities of the County crews. Matt Greiner was present with pictures and other printed materials relating to his concerns with road width and what is, in his opinion, excessive crown height on 160th Street on the east side of Highway 63. No action was taken but the group agreed Engineer Schock and Maintenance Supervisor, Kurt Bulechek will investigate and possibly address the alleged problematic issues being reported by Mr. Greiner.
