The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, June 8, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, June 1, 2026.

The Board met with Vince Tyson concerning the removal of five trees located in the County right-of-way adjacent to his parcel. Shade from said trees contribute to excessive moisture on the roadway for longer periods of time after precipitation. Mr. Tyson indicated that although it is his opinion that improper drainage is another contributing factor of the issue, he would not be opposed to removal of the trees but asked the Board to consider reimbursing him the cost of replacing the trees at another location on his parcel. Details regarding tree and stump removal need to be worked out before the Board can take action, at which time they will contact Mr. Tyson to be placed on the agenda for a future meeting.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, mowing, rock hauling, ditching and cross-road pipe repair work of the County crews. He further reported having been informed by Douds Stone they are raising their price per ton of rock by 21 percent. The group then discussed that on July 1, 2026, the speed limit on two-lane, hard-surfaced roads will raise to 60 miles per hour, creating the need to replace signs on said roads throughout the County which, in turn, creates additional expense for counties due a State legislative law change.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve a utility permit for Citizens Mutual Telephone Cooperative on Doe Avenue.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve a utility permit for Wapello Rural Water Association on 145<sup>th</sup> Street.

Dave Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve use of the courtyard for the "Meet the Mustangs" event scheduled to be held on Wednesday, August 26, 2026.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.

At 1:00 p.m. the Board reconvened for an informational/round table discussion with members of the Iowa State Association of Counties staff who were in Davis County as part of their "99-County Tour".

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the following claims to be paid:
