The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, June 29, 2026 with Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present. Chairman Ron Bride was absent.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, June 22, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, mowing, rock hauling, ditching and cross-road pipe replacement work of the County crews. The Richard Harris bridge project is complete and the road will officially open later this morning. Schock further reported having received three bids for the Jade Avenue bridge project, being: Herberger \$165,627.00; BRS (old Stateline) \$168,008.00; and IBC \$197,170.00.

After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve the following Resolution:

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE PLACE AT WHICH NOTICE OF MEETINGS OF THE
DAVIS COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SHALL BE POSTED**

WHEREAS, the Davis County Board of Supervisors (the “Board”) is a governmental body subject to the requirements of the Iowa Open Meetings Law, Iowa Code Chapter 21; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Legislature has amended Iowa’s Open Meetings statute to require every governmental body to designate annually a prominent and conspicuous place for posting notice of its meetings;

WHEREAS, beginning on July 1, 2026, such notice must be visible at all times for at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting for which notice is being given; and

WHEREAS, HF 2490 also requires notice and tentative agenda to be posted on the governmental body’s primary internet site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR DAVIS COUNTY, IOWA:

Section 1. At least one full business day prior to the commencement of each meeting of the Davis County Board of Supervisors from June 29, 2026, through and including January 4, 2027, the Davis County Auditor shall post a meeting agenda, including the time, date, and place of the meeting, facing outward, on the glass exterior door on the west side of the Davis County Courthouse.

Section 2. At its January 4, 2027, organizational meeting, and at every annual organizational meeting thereafter, the Davis County Board of Supervisors shall designate the place at which notice of its meetings shall be posted for the following year.

Section 3: In addition to the physical posting location designated in Section 1, all public notices and tentative agendas shall be posted and regularly maintained on the county’s primary internet site at: www.daviscountyiowa.gov

Section 4: Nothing in this resolution shall supersede the requirement to advise news media who have filed a request for notice with the county, or the requirement to fulfill the 24-hour advance notice of meetings as mandated by Iowa Code section 21.4.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Davis County, Iowa on June 29, 2026 and the vote thereon being as follows: AYES: David Henderson, Alan Yahnke NAYS: None

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the World-Wide Bible Reading Marathon Organization to use the courtyard pavilion on Tuesday, July 14, 2026.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve transferring the time capsule created in 1976 by American Legion Post #78, which has been stored in the Auditor’s vault, to American Legion Post #78.
