The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 10, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

Alan made motion, seconded by David and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David made motion, seconded by Alan and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 3, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, mowing, rock hauling and ditching work completed by the County crews. He further reported that dust control application by Binns and Stevens scheduled for August 7th was pushed back to August 12. The group then discussed various pieces of county equipment and what replacing some of said equipment might look like in the future and whether to trade in, sell or keep existing equipment.

The Board then met with County Attorney Rick Lynch, Recorder Megan Clyman, Treasurer Mike Johnson, Deputy Assessor Rhonda Norton, Deputy Clerk of Court Kendra Taylor, Auditor Kristi Goodson and Appanoose-Davis-Lucas-Monroe (ADLM) Emergency Management Director Mike Lamb (by phone) to discuss the possibility of closing the Courthouse to the public for one day in February, 2027 to complete several security trainings, rather than trying to schedule the necessary trainings and coordinate schedules on different days throughout the year. No action was taken.
