The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 3, 2026, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David made motion, seconded by Alan and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan made motion, seconded by David and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, July 27, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, mowing, rock hauling and ditching work of County crews.

The Board met with Kim Smith, representing the Pulaski Corn Show Committee, who asked for South Second Street in Pulaski, from Highway 2 and going North approximately 200 feet and going South approximately 375 feet to be temporarily closed from 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. to accommodate a 5K Run/Walk, Hawkeye Pedal Pull and a car show held in conjunction with the Pulaski Corn Show on September 12, 2026. David made motion, seconded by Alan and carried unanimously, to approve the temporary closure and provide barricades.
