The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, July 27, 2026 with Chairman Ron Bride and Members David Henderson and Alan Yahnke present.

David made motion, seconded by Alan and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan made motion, seconded by David and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, July 20, 2026.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, mowing, rock hauling, ditching and cross-road pipe repair/replacement work of the County crews. He further reported that in its bridge inspections for Davis County, Calhoun-Burns posted no changes for 2026.

David made motion, seconded by Alan and carried unanimously, to approve and sign a utility permit for Citizen’s Mutual on 285th Street.

Alan made motion, seconded by David and carried unanimously, to approve the Annual Service Agreement with My Cloud Hosting for the County’s website, which includes the addition of Americans With Disability Act (ADA) compliance piece, the total annual premium being \$5,988, presented by Information Technology (IT) Administrator, Megan Clyman.

The Board met with Lyle Stirling representing Spectrum Center for the Arts, part of the Davis County Fine Arts Council. In celebration of America’s 250th Anniversary and in conjunction with the Community Choir Concert on September 13th, the group recruited five artists to create red, white and blue-themed paintings of the Courthouse to be held at silent auction with proceeds going to the artists. David made motion, seconded by Alan and carried unanimously, to approve Spectrum Center for the Arts to display these five paintings in the Courthouse at the southwest end of the main hallway from August 3-14.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
